### **N5J Jarvis Island DXpedition –update August 1**

Getting ready for Jarvis N5J. Here's Don N1DG building a 6 mtr beam. Earlier, he setup Superfox on 7 PCs. Team leave for Jarvis Friday early (local American Samoa time). As with all major DXpeditions , N5J will be fully documented here on DX-World.



### **K8R American Samoa -now QRT**

After a successful test operation in preparation of the upcoming Jarvis Island DXpedition, we are dismantling the antennas today (July 28th) and going QRT. Final logs will be posted to Club Log soon. Superfox performed much better than we've ever seen F/H do and we experimented with many QRP stations. We expect to depart for Jarvis on August 2 – however we are watching a storm which could change plans. See you from N5J and thanks for the K8R QSOs. The N5J team.

### **3D2Z Rotuma DXpedition 2024 -update**

We are pleased to announce that our good friends at DX Engineering (DXE) are a major sponsor of the 3D2Z Rotuma DXpedition scheduled for late November. DXE has now joined the Northern California DX Foundation (NCDXF) as a "Premier" sponsor supporting this unique DXpedition. This DXpedition is a partnership with Youth on the Air (YOTA) encouraging youth participation and will

feature 3 young operators who will be active from 3D2Z on the Island while there will also be 30 or more YOTA operators operating 3D2Z remotely using W6IZT Radio in a Box stations (RiBs) over Starlink.

### **African Tour by Pista HA5AO -update**

Pista, HA5AO says he has received the LotW certificates for his Z22AO, 9J2AO, A25AO and V51/HA5AO callsigns. The QTHs are fully booked. The visa to Namibia is applied and hopefully will be granted soon. All the equipment and antennas tested and packed in 3 baggages. The total weight is 92 kg, excluding personal stuff. He leaves on 1st September and will arrive to Victoria Falls International Airport, Zimbabwe on the 2nd Sept. The first signals can be expected on 3rd. A reminder of his schedule below in previous news update.

Pista also says the QTHs are in or around natural parks. The lodges are protected by electric fence keeping the big wild animals away. These electric fences may generate high noise level, but he hopes that it will not make CW impossible. He was advised that monkeys and baboons can enter the premises, and hopes they will not damage his main antenna – this is the reason Pista decided to use the sturdier Hustler vertical antenna and not the lightweight DX Commander even if it significantly increases the weight of his baggage.

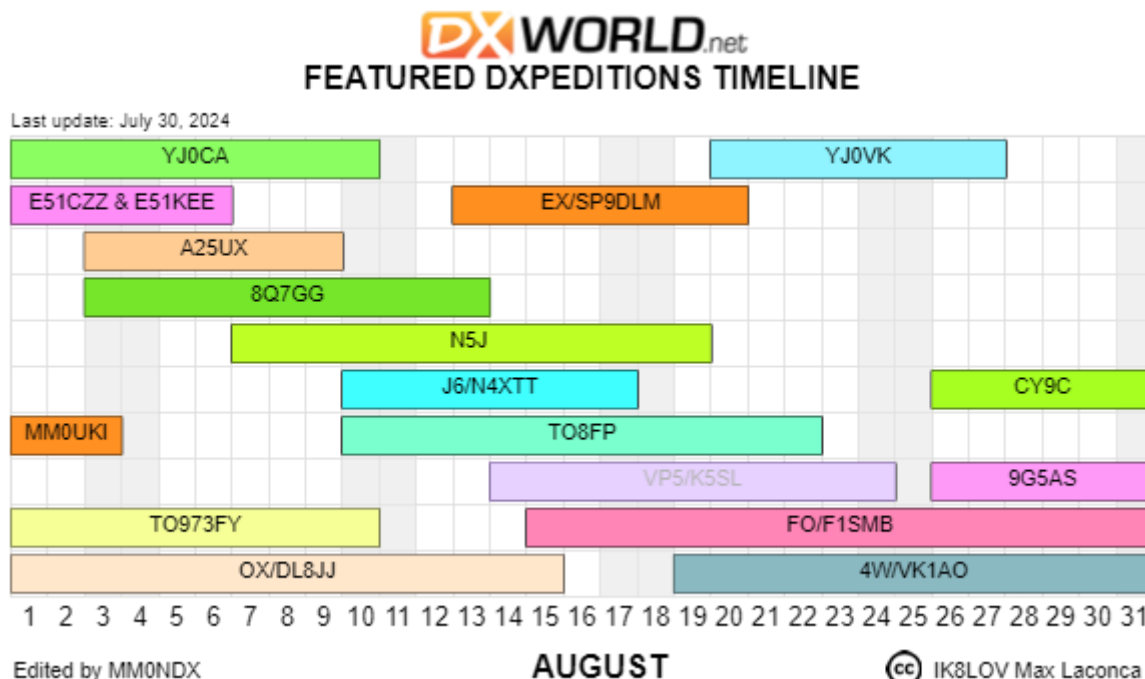
**KH5, JARVIS ISL** In March the Dateline DX Association was pleased to announce that it has received permission from the USFWS for a DXpedition to Jarvis Island National Wildlife Reserve this August. Jarvis is ranked nr. 18 on Clublog's global most wanted list. It is number 9 in Europe. In some EU countries Jarvis is ranked as high as second most wanted on phone and digi. Jarvis is ranked higher than Bouvet (16) in Europe. It is 450 miles from Palmyra Atoll and 1500 miles from Hawaii.

An experienced team of five consisting of George, AA7JV, Don, N1DG, Tomi, HA7RY, Adrian, KO8SCA, and Mike, KN4EEI, will install 6 RIB stations on Jarvis. The at-island team will be augmented by 24 remote operators from Asia, Europe and North America. All phone, 160 and 6 mtr operations will be done locally. The local ops will also operate CW and FT8 on all bands. The remote operators will operate on 80 to 10 meters using CW and FT8 modes. We are permitted 12 days of operation but the permit is good for the whole month of August to allow for weather issues. <https://jarvisisland2024.com/>

**EU-118 Flannan Isl** A team of five UK ops will attempt to activate MM0UKI from the Flannan Islands EU-118 in August. The uninhabited island group is 20 miles (32km) west of the Isle of Lewis in the Outer Hebrides. It is 6th 'most wanted' IOTA in Europe and 2nd in the UK (after Rockall). The team consists of Rockall DXpedition veteran Nobby G0VJG, John G4IRN, Paul G4PVM, Mike GM5AUG and Jamie M0SDV. The ferry tickets have been booked from Ullapool (mainland Scotland) to Lewis and a private charter boat will take the team to Flannan.

The trip is weather dependent – departure to the island is planned for 1st August, with the 2nd being a contingency day. Activity will be on 40m to 6m SSB and CW from three stations and will continue until the first available weather window for departure on 4th August or thereafter.

**EU-174 Ammouliani Isl** Savas, SV2AEL is QRV as call/8 until August 10. Operation from 80 to 10 meter and perhaps 6 meter if propagation permits. QSL via LoTW, Club Log and direct via home call.

Pista, HA5AO – celebrating 50 years anniversary of his HAM license – informs DX-World that he will be active from four African countries in September/October 2024. The operating sites are within 40-80 km circle of the common borders of Zimbabwe, Zambia, Botswana and Namibia. Ten days of operation can be expected from each country on CW, SSB, and FT8 from 80m up to 6m. The licenses are in hand, the QTHs are booked. He will use K3S and FT-710 transceivers with KPA 500 power amplifier. The antenna is a DX Commander vertical for 40-6m bands and multi-band inverted-V (80m-6m) on a 12m HD Spider pole, donated by Spiderbeam. The planned schedule is as follows,

The larger, main island (Atlantic Cove site) is controlled by the Canadian Wildlife Service and is off-limits. DXpeditions can only be set up on the much smaller "Northeast" Island (Rock!). The CY9C team will once again have a helicopter available to access the Northeast Island as there is no dock or landing area for a boat. Much more information, including a website, will be available later this year and into 2024.

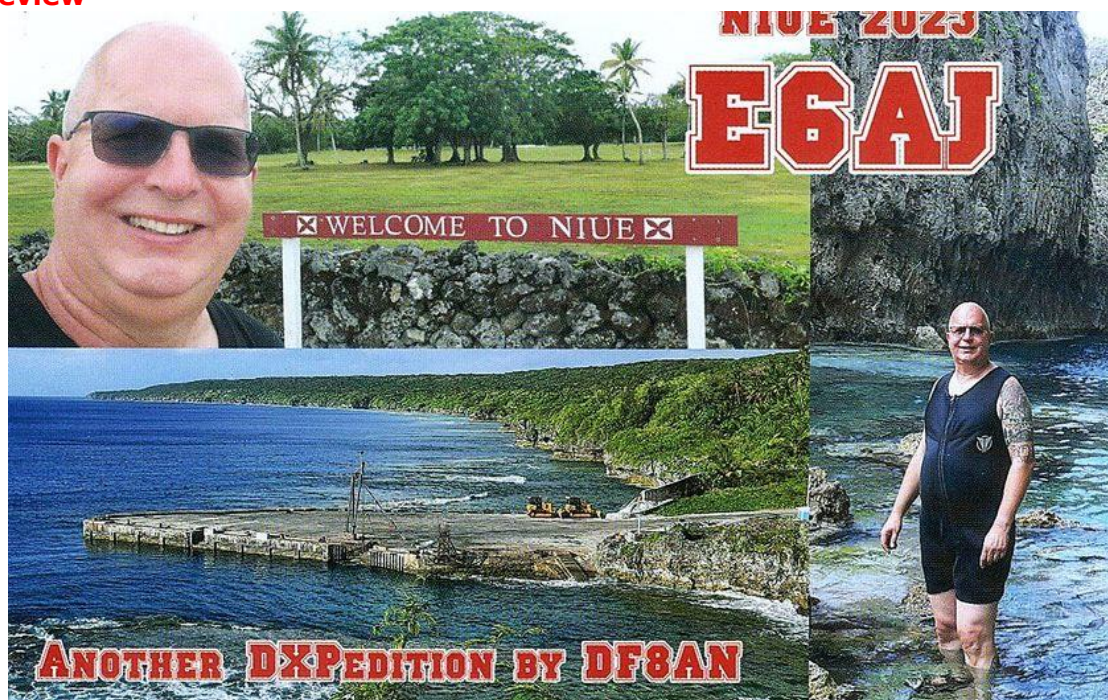
